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
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
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







"You will have great fun in school," Pranav's mother told him,

"Hatti won't go to school with you," Pranav's mother told him.


> "Why can't he go with me?" Pranav asked.

your books!"


"I don't want to go to school!" Pranav said, "I don't want to leave you all at home and go!"

[&]quot;There will be lots of other children there and new toys and..."




"But I don't want to leave you and Hatti and Monkey and go!"

"All of us," Pranav's mother said, "Hatti and Monkey! Me and your doggy and your doll and all your books! And your swing and your red cycle!"







